## The Vision.

The Thiensville and Mequon Rotary clubs are working together to construct a 1.3 mile scenic riverwalk trail in honor of Rotary International's 100 years of service to the World. The trail will allow Mequon and Thiensville residents and their visitors easy access to the beauty and tranquility of the Milwaukee River.

## How You Can Help.

The Master Plan has been developed; the project is proceeding in segments as finances and easements allow. In 2007, thanks to the cooperation of the affected property owners we completed construction of the "Library" segment located within the City of Mequon. In 2008, our project focus includes developing a mutually satisfactory site design for the "Overlook" segment. If the affected property owner agrees to provide us with an easement, we will be applying for a matching grant in hopes of construction in the fall. In addition, we are also going to pursue raising the funds necessary to install project informational signs along the completed phases of the project.
